## ORDER

In pursuance of the consensus arrived at in the meeting held on 10/07/2017, Government as per the Order read above have approved the fee structure for admission to MBBS course in Dr Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam for the academic year 2017-18. Accordingly, Government and Management of Dr Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam entered into consensual agreement with specific terms and conditions regarding admission to MBBS Course for the academic year 2017-18

2. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to accord sanction for the admission of students in MBBS course in Dr Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam through the centralised allotment to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations subject to the conditions stipulated in the letter 4<sup>th</sup> cited for admitting 2 (two) seats in the Government quota for the academic year 2017-18 (ie, Government merit seats -77 and Management quota -73 for the year 2017-18) and also following terms and conditions;

i. Total seats ie, 150 seats in the the Educational Agency will be filled up

by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list of candidates who have qualified in the NEET [UG] 2017, through common counselling.Of this,77 seats in the year 2017-18 will be filled up in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time, subject to clause 2 below.

ii. For Minority Community 23 seats out of 77 seats (for the year 2017-18) will be filled up by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the list of students belonging to the minority community which established the college and based on their inter se merit, as mentioned below:-

(a) Eighteen (18) seats from SIUC Nadar Community of South Kerala Diocese

of CSI allotted based on the inter se merit of the applicants

(b) Two (2) seats are to be allotted from Dalit Christian, SIUC candidates of SKD and Kollam - Kottarakara Diocese of CSI based on the inter se merit of the applicant.

(c) Three (3) seats shall be allotted to the members of CSI SKD other than the categories mentioned under (a) & (b) above based on the inter se merit belonging to other communities from SIUC actively practicing in the

Churches of SKD of CSI.

(d) In the event of non availability of candidates in (c) above, two seats will be added to (a) above ie, SIUC Nadar Community and one seat will be added to (b) ie, Dalit Christian SIUC. If candidates are not available in (b) and (c) above, seats will be filled up from (a) above. If candidates are not available in (a), (b) & (c), the seats will be added to General merit.

iii. Remaining 50% ie, 73 (for the year 2017-18) Management Quota seats will be allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, through Common Counselling from the Categories mentioned below, by virtue of the minority status being enjoyed by the college, vide order No.489/2006 dt 22/6/2006 of the Secretary, National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, New Delhi.

Note: In the absence of candidate in category (1) above, vacancy shall be filled from category (2) and (3) and vice versa. In the absence of any candidates from the above 3 classes it shall be filled up with Christian candidates from Kerala.

iv. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, shall permit the non-kerala students to apply online against the 28 seats in relaxation of Kerala Engineering, Architecture and Medical Prospectus 2017. The CSI Management shall submit paper application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations who inturn will allow online applications for this categoy. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, through notification shall specify that at the time of Common Counselling, the students belonging to minority community will be required to furnish the necessary proof regarding their minority status from Revenue Authority and submit in writing about their willingness to take admission and pay the requisite fee in the minority college ie the Educational Agency. There shall be only two rounds of Common Counselling by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The Candidates and their parents are required to submit their consent before Commissioner for Entrance Examinations regarding their willingness to pay

the fee provided in the notification, along with other documents and take admission in the college. After 2 rounds of Counselling and spot admission Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, shall determine the number of seats that are still vacant and forward to the college a list of students in the order of merit equal to ten times the number of vacant seats, so that in case of any stray vacancy arising in the college, such vacancy can be filled up from the above list. Such candidate should confirm their minority status as well as the fact that they fulfill other conditions prescribed by the college. Accordingly, the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, shall prepare separate list of minority students who produce the community certificate from the Revenue Authority seeking admission to the college in the order of merit. The competent authorities of the college shall present during Counselling and check the minority status of the candidate. The Candidates who belongs to the Minority Community should produce certificate from the Revenue Authority to get their claim admitted.

- v. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in Educational Agency and the Educational Agency shall admit the students specified in the list in the order of merit. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, submission of DD and agreement in Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred) stamp paper signed by the candidate and parents consenting to pay the annual fee and relevant records. The Educational Agency need admit only those students who have complied with the instructions given by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- vi. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, shall furnish the allotment list of the students to be admitted to the Educational Agency according to the time schedule published by him. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, will not re-allot students already allotted to the College and admitted in the College, after the final allotment. The students must join the college on or before last date of joining the course.
- vii. The Educational Agency shall be entitled to fill up those seats still remaining unfilled after the closure of allotment including spot admission by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. These vacant seats will be filled up by the college from the list of the students forwarded by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the direction of the Honourable Supreme Court and the fee payable shall be that collected from the management candidates.
- viii. If any student is not admitted by the Educational Agency for specific defects or for reasons to be recorded in writing, it shall intimate the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the Educational Agency shall accept and admit the students

accordingly following the above procedures. The Educational Agency shall be entitled to fill those seats still remaining unfilled after the entire allotment process including spot allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the list forwarded by him. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations/Government shall not have any claim over such seats and the forfeited seats shall not be brought forward to succeeding year for compensation.

ix. The Government and the Educational Agency after series of discussions with the representatives of the minority community agree to collect annual fees at the following concessional rates from the most meritorious students and students belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes admitted under the 50% Government merit Quota, during the entire course period from 2017-18.

(a) (i)	Students belonging to BPL /SEBC family , not exceeding 40% seats of Govt. Merit Quota, [i.e, 14% from BPL families and 26% from SEBC students				
(ii)	If there are no sufficient candidates in the BPL category above, candidates with lowest income based on Income Certificate issued by the competent Revenue authority will be considered.				
(b)	Other Candidates including those who have got admission under SC/ST reservation categories not exceeding 60% seats of Govt. Merit Quota, [i.e, 8%, from SC and 2% from ST and 50% from General Merit quota]	annum. Fee for SC/ST/OEC			

Duly signed and sealed receipt shall be given by the Educational Agency for all the fees collected. Annual fees for the category mentioned in clause 9(b) will be directly paid by the students to the Educational Agency. Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, will deduct only Rs.10,000 from the students mentioned in clause ix (a) and (b) and this amount will be transferred to the Educational Agency within 45 days of admission failing which the Educational Agency can claim interest on the payment.

x. The Educational Agency shall be entitled to collect Caution Deposit from every student admitted to the College, Caution Deposit of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) and other expenses and such other permitted amounts shall be collected from students joining in the Educational Agency. The Educational Agency can also collect from students their proportionate share of fees payable to the University, Government, Medical Council of India fees, transportation charges, Examinations conducting charges, extra curricular and other establishment charges etc.. The Educational Agency will

ensure that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specifie above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any students admitted to the Educational Agency.

- xi. The remaining 50% of the seats (i.e 73 Seats in the year 2017-18) shall be filled up by the following methods.
  - (a) The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, shall allot to the Educational Agency who is entitled to fill up 15% seats of the total seats in the Non-Resident Indian category (NRI) by admitting NEET Qualified Candidates who are children/dependents of Non Resident Indians, belonging to the categories specifically mentioned in para iii above subject to GO(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013 and GO(MS)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. Vacant seats in any particular category shall be filled on the basis of merit from the other categories as per conditions stipulated in the above Orders.

(b) Each Student thus admitted by the Educational Agency to the above mentioned 15% seats as mentioned in clause xi (a) shall pay annual tuition fee of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only), for which signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the Educational Agency. In addition, the Educational Agency is permitted to collect an amount not exceeding one year fee of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) from the candidates in this category as interest free deposit to be returned on completion of the course. The Educational Agency can also collect from students their proportionate share of fees payable to the Universities, Government fees, Medical Council of India fees, transportation charges, Examinations conducting charges, extra-curricular and other establishment charges etc. Such fees and amounts shall be specifically listed out and published each year by the Educational Agency without changes from the first year of fees paid. The candidate shall deposit with the admission counseling committee the demand draft towards the fees to be paid/payable to the Principal of the college. The Admission / Counselling Committee shall forthwith forward the DD to the Principal of the college.

(c) The Educational Agency shall fill up the remaining 35% of the total seats as allotted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by common counselling from the applications received by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for the categorization mentioned by the minority community running the institutions, in the order of merit list prepared based on the rank secured by the candidates in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test - UG 2017 (NEET UG-2017) based on inter-se merit. The Educational Agency shall apportion the seats within this 35%, to various categories or within the community or denominations thereof, based on inter-se merit following the specifications detailed in the prospectus approved by the Admission Supervisory Committee subject to the production of Community Certificate from Revenue Authority. The Candidates shall submit a consent in stamp paper worth `200 (Two Hundred Rupees)

countersigned by the parents that they knowingly and willfully decided to opt for the higher fees approved by the Fee Regulatory Committee/ Government and shall be notified in the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and prospectus of the Educational Agency and in the agreement and Government Order.

(d) Each Student thus admitted by the Educational Agency to the above mentioned 35% seats as mentioned in clause xi (c) shall pay annual tuition fee of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs only), for which signed and sealed receipts shall be issued by the Educational Agency. In addition, the Educational Agency can collect an amount not exceeding one year fee of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs only) from the students in this category as interest free deposit which shall be refunded at the end of the course. The Educational Agency can also collect from students their proportionate share of fees payable to the Universities, Government fees, Medical Council of India fees, transportation charges, Examinations conducting charges, extracurricular and other establishment charges etc by approval of Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee. Such fees and amounts shall be specifically listed out and published each year by the Educational Agency. In the event of them obtaining admission for Post Graduate studies the same obligation shall be executed after the completion of their PG study where the management shall in no way have a differential remuneration based on qualification for the period of service obligation.

(e) All Students thus selected under Management Quota shall remit the said amount as mentioned above for the first year of the course and produce a bank guarantee from Nationalized Bank or Scheduled Bank for an amount covering the fee for the remaining four years, i.e. for the entire course of study. The Educational Agency is entitled to refuse admission to those candidates who fail to submit/furnish Bank Guarantee before the last date of joining the course under intimation to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for allotment

of a replacement candidate.

xii. The Educational Agency can retain the tuition fee remitted by the student in the event the student admitted under the Management Quota or Government Quota, discontinues his/her studies for any reason at any time after closure of admission. Further, in case, any student admitted to the Educational Agency decides to cancel the admission for any reason whatsoever, the Educational Agency shall be entitled to collect the tuition fee for the entire course. However, in the event of the seat so falling vacant being filled up by a new candidate, the tuition fee collected as per this clause shall be refunded.

xiii. The Educational Agency shall ensure that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the Educational Agency. It shall be the liability of the Educational Agency to

redress complaints from the students, on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement in consultation with the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations,. Where the Educational Agency fails to redress any complaints referred to as above or on any matter covered under this agreement, it shall be the duty of the First party to take such steps as required under law to redress the complaints.

- xiv. The Government shall arrange to provide PHC/CHC/Autopsy perceiving facilities and ensure supply of cadavers required for the College as per the norms fixed by the Government. If any charges are applied by the Government for these facilities, the Educational Agency is entitled to collect the same from the students.
- xv. The Educational Agency will be free to execute appropriate Service obligation bond from the students admitted under Government merit quota for a period not exceeding one year. In the event of the candidate obtaining admission to Post Graduate Course or higher speciality course the service obligation shall be executed after completion of Post Graduate/ Higher speciality course of study where the management shall in no way have a differential remuneration for the service of obligation. If the candidates who have availed the Government Merit Quota seat desire to break the service obligation, they should pay liquidated damages to the minimum of Rs.5,00,000 (Rupees Five lakhs only) to the Educational Agency.
- xvi. The Consensual Agreement entered into with the Educational Agency is valid for all admitted candidates of the Academic Year 2017-18 only and shall not prejudicially affect the rights of the parties by virtue of the clauses herein, in respect of the cases pending before any court of law.
- xvii. It shall be the duty of the first party to submit this consensual agreement before the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee constituted by the State of Kerala for post facto approval.
- xviii. Nothing in this agreement shall be deemed as a surrender of the unconditional right of the Minority Educational Agency regarding the admission of students in all the seats in the college.
- xix. In the event of this agreement being set aside by any authority competent to do so, the fees and conditions fixed by Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee shall prevail.

xx. Candidates who receive allotment under Government quota/Management/NRI quota shall remit the requisite fee by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram or as Notified by the CEE.
