**SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES**  
**ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY**

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses including MBBS/BDS courses will commence on **07.08.2018**. In the second phase, allotment will be done to the vacant seats existing in Medical & Allied courses, seats liable to be surrendered from All India Quota to State Quota and the newly included colleges under Medical & Allied courses also. Candidates who want to be considered for this phase of allotment shall have to perform **Online Option Confirmation**. After Online Option Confirmation, candidates can register fresh options to the newly included colleges under Medical & Allied courses and also can re-arrange their existing higher options / delete the unwanted higher options. The Facility for Online Option Confirmation and registration of fresh options/re-arranging the existing higher options/deleting the unwanted higher options will be available in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) up to **10 am on 11.08.2018 (Saturday)**. The "Facilitation Centres" [FC] having internet facility, will be functioning throughout the State during this period for providing necessary help to the candidates for registration of options. The details of such centers are available on the above website.

The higher order options that remained after the first phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses of those candidates who have not joined the college allotted in the first phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses and those who have discontinued the course after joining have been cancelled. Also candidates who stand admitted in MBBS/BDS courses under All India Quota, if details provided by the Medical Counselling Committee, shall not be considered for the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses.

Candidates who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses shall have to log into their Home Page provided in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can register fresh options to the newly included colleges under Medical & Allied courses and can re-arrange / delete their higher order options up to **10 am on 11.08.2018** through the above website. The allotment on the basis of options received within the stipulated time will be published on **12.08.2018**. The candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment on any date from **13.08.2018** to **17.08.2018** and should join the course/college allotted before **5 pm on 17.08.2018**. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website.

**DETAILED SCHEDULE FOR THE SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT**

07.08.2018	Website opens for <b>Online Option Confirmation</b> and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options and registration of fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges.
11.08.2018 (10 am)	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion/addition of options ends
<b>12.08.2018</b>	<b>Publication of Second Phase Allotment</b>
13.08.2018 to 17.08.2018	Candidates who receive allotment should remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to CEE in any of the Head Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
17.08.2018 (5 pm)	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System ( <b>OAMS</b> ).

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for being considered in this phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses for both candidates allotted with a course in the previous phase and those who have not received any allotment in the previous phase. Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses. However, those candidates who have performed online option confirmation during the period from 23.07.2018 to 26.07.2018 when the facility for the same was available for Medical & Allied courses prior to the vacancy filling online allotment to Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy course need not perform online option confirmation again for this allotment. The existing allotment of those candidates who do not perform online option confirmation shall be retained if he/she stands joined the course/college as per the previous allotment.

Candidates can register fresh options in this phase to the following colleges which were not considered for allotment in the first phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses.

**Note:**

- 1) Kannur Medical College, Anjarakkandi, Kannur, a Private Self Financing Medical College has been excluded from allotment process as per the orders dated 25.07.2018 of the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) and as per the instructions dated 27.07.2018 of Kerala University of Health Sciences.
- 2) Candidates are advised to file/retain options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
- 3) Those candidates who do not want to be considered for the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses should invariably delete their existing options.
- 4) The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they produce the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before 5 pm on 10.08.2018.

**Token Deposit :**

Candidates getting allotment afresh who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Registered Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have to remit token deposit of Rs. 1000/- to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as token of having accepted the allotment and should join the college allotted within the stipulated time.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies, Affiliation from the Universities and Government Orders.

Vacant seats, if any, under MBBS/BDS courses remaining after 17.08.2018 will be filled up through a Mop-up Counselling scheduled to be conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> of August 2018 by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The detailed notification relating to Mop-up Counselling will be published later.
