ORDER

As per the Order read above, Government have approved the fee structure for admission to MBBS and BDS courses in Pariyaram Medical College under Academy of Medical science for the academic year 2017-18. Accordingly, Government and Management of Academy of Medical Science entered into consensual agreement with specific terms and conditions regarding admission to BDS Course for the academic year 2017-18 in Pariyaram Medical College, Pariyaram, Kanr pr.

2. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to accord sanction for the admission of students in BDS course in Pariyaram Medical College under Academy of Medical science through the centralised allotment to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations(CEE) subject to following terms and conditions:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (i). 50% of the total seats in the Dental College, Academy of Medical Sciences will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.
- (ii). The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the Management and the Management shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instruction as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The Management shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as given by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish such lists on or before the 25th day of August 2017.

(iii). If any student is not admitted by the Management for specific defects or for any reason to be recorded in writing, it shall intimate to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the Management shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5 PM on 25.08.2017.

(iv). The Management shall be entitled to collect annual fees at the following concessional rates from the students admitted under the 50% Government Merit quota during the entire course period as mentioned below:-

a	Students belonging to BPL family as per State Government norms (06 students)	Rs.23,000/-
b	If there are not enough candidates in (a) above, candidates with low annual family income, based on income certificates to be produced from competent authority; but the total number not exceeding 06 that is, 20% of the total Government seats, for both (a) and (b) together.	
c	Candidates who have got admission under SEBC reservation categories (08 students)	Rs.44,000/-
d	Candidates who have got admission under SC/ST reservation categories	Rs. 2,10,000/- (To be provided by Government of Kerala)
e	Other candidates	Rs.2,10,000/-

Duly signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the Management/college for all fees collected. Annual tuition fees for SC/ST students admitted under Government quota shall be paid by the Government.

(v). The annual fees fixed as above shall be inclusive of all amounts collected as in the case of similarly situated students in Government Colleges. However, the Management shall be entitled to collect such other statutorily permitted fees and such other amounts collected from similarly situated students in Government Dental Colleges or Government controlled Self Financing Dental Colleges which shall be specifically listed out and published each year during the entire course of study. The Management shall not collect any amount from any student so admitted, other than those specified above.

(vi). 35% of the total seats shall be treated as Management seats and shall be filled up from among the candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by CBSE on the basis of inter se merit and who have opted for management seats based on their inter se merit and allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

(vii). Each student thus admitted by the Management to the above mentioned 35% seats shall pay annual tuition fees up to Rs 4,00,000/- or such amount as fixed by the

Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee of the Government, for which signed receipts with seal shall be given.

(viii). The Management shall be entitled to fill up the remaining 15% seats by eligible students who are children/ dependants of Non Resident Indians . The selection of candidates shall be as per rank list prepared on the basis of inter se merit of NEET . Such student shall be liable to pay annual tuition fees up to Rs.5,00,000/- .

(ix). The Management undertakes that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the college. It shall be the liability of the Management to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement. Where the Management fails to redress any complaints referred to, as above or any matter covered under this agreement, it shall be the duty of the first party to take such steps as required under law to redress the complaint.

(x). The Government shall consider providing facilities for clinical training and other assistance in Government hospital for dental college students of the Management, based on the applications submitted by the college, on case to case basis.

(xi). The consensual agreement shall be submitted by the First Party/ Second Party before the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee constituted by the State Government and shall be subject to their approval.

(xii). The Management shall be entitled to collect tuition fees approved/ endorsed for BDS by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee in the State, from all students, in the event of this consensual agreement not got approved as stipulated in clause 11 above or consensual agreement is declared to be void or not enforceable by the Court or any authority competent to declare so.


