ADMISSION TO B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE, 2021

FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The First phase Centralised Allotment for admission to B. Pharm (Lateral Entry) Course in Government Pharmacy Colleges and Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2021 is published herewith on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment is based on the rank list of the online Entrance Examination and the online options registered by the candidates within the stipulated time.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, and Password in the **‘B.Pharm (LE) 2021 - Candidate Portal’** provided in the above website. Then by clicking the menu item **‘Allotment Result’**, candidates can view their allotment and can download the allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, Roll number, allotment details, tuition fees etc. are available on the allotment memo. The allotment memo and data sheet will be available on the home page of the candidate from **20.10.2022** onwards. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu Item **‘Data Sheet’** for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who get allotment should take admission to the concerned college from **21.10.2022 to 25.10.2022** before **3.00 pm** along with the allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause.7.3.8 of the Prospectus. They should pay the complete fees as specified in the concerned government order to the allotted college authorities at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **4.00 pm** on **25.10.2022**.

The candidates, who do not join the college within the stipulated time, will lose their present allotment and higher order options.
