Facility for Option Registration for Vacancy Filling Allotment Enabled

The rank list revised by including those candidates who have newly qualified based on the reduction in the qualifying percentile for NEET PG 2021 Examination is published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The candidates included in the rank list may give options for the seats in the DNB Post MBBS Diploma & DNB Post MBBS.

Candidates may register options to any of the Speciality, Institution combinations they wish to study irrespective of the present vacancy status as any vacancy arising during the process of allotment will be filled based on the options registered in this phase. The selection and ordering of options (Speciality & Institution combinations which the candidate would like to join if allotted) should be done. The facility for selection and ordering of the options shall be available in the link 'OPTION REGISTRATION' available in the Candidate Portal of DNB(Post MBBS) & Post MBBS Diploma 2021. This will be available **till 27/4/2022, 10.00AM.**

Based on the options registered by candidates, the allotment will be published on 28.04.2022. If a candidate who is already admitted in DNB Post MBBS 2021 through the previous allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations gets allotment to his higher option through this phase, the existing admission of the candidate shall be cancelled. The details of subsequent allotment if any will be notified later.

Candidates shall read the details given in the Information Bulletin for admission to DNB Post MBBS and DNB Post MBBS Diploma State In-service quota 2021-22 published in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
