NOTIFICATION KERALA MANAGEMENT APTITUDE TEST-SESSION II ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR MBA(KMAT-2022)

APPLICATION INVITED

Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination to MBA Course, Kerala Management Aptitude Test (Second Session of KMAT-2022).

I. Eligibility

Nationality and Nativity: Indians and Non Indians are eligible to apply. But, only Keralite candidates are eligible for all types of reservation or fee concession.

Age: No restrictions.

Academic qualifications: Candidate should have completed the Bachelors Degree of minimum three years duration in the field of Arts, Engineering, Commerce, Management or equivalent to satisfy the eligibility criteria for the course. Candidates who are appearing for the final year of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply, provided their results are declared before the commencement of the admission process for the KMAT 2022. Candidates should have attained the minimum marks as stipulated for admission to MBA course by the respective universities to which the candidate wishes to apply.

Note: Documents in proof of applicable eligibilities (Nationality Nativity, reservations, Age, Academic qualification etc.) shall be produced before the College/University authorities at the time of admission. None of these documents need to be uploaded with the online application or submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examination (CEE).

II. Computer Based Test

The Entrance Examination (Computer Based Test) will be conducted at

centers across all districts in Kerala on a date to be announced later by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The Entrance Examination will be of Three hours duration and will consist of 180 Objective Type questions of four marks each (Total 180x4=720). For every wrong answer one mark will be deducted. The questions will be based on

- (a) English Language Usage and Reading Comprehension (50 Questions)
- **(b)** Quantitative Aptitude (50 Questions)
- (c) Data sufficiency and Logical Reasoning (40 Questions)
- (d) General Awareness and current affairs (40 Questions)

Detailed time schedule and other instructions regarding the examination will be notified later.

III. Qualifying Marks

The cut-off marks for General/SEBC category candidates is 10 % of the total 720 marks, i.e.,72 marks and SC/ST/PD category candidates is 7.5% of the total marks, i.e., 54 marks. Candidates who get qualified in the K-MAT Examination will be eligible for admission to MBA Course in various Universities/Departments and other Management Colleges in Kerala.

IV. Submission of Online Application and Application Fee

The application fee is Rs.1000-(Rupees One Thousand only) for General and SEBC candidates and Rs.750/-(Rupees Seven hundred and Fifty only) for SC/ST candidates (See Annexure I,II, III of the KMAT-2022 Information Bulletin for SEBC, SC, ST lists). Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from 22.07.2022 to 30.07.2022, 05:00 PM and then remit the required application fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available while applying online for the entrance examination. They can use Internet Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card for online payment. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post Offices in Kerala. After remitting the fee the candidate has to upload a recent passport size colour photograph and signature to the online application. After completing the application candidates download submission procedure, can the Application Acknowledgement Page and keep a copy of it for future reference. Fees will

neither be carried forward to a future examination nor refunded. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. Candidates must note that mere deduction of fee from the Bank account is not a proof of fee payment. In the event of a successful payment, the **Pay Application Fee** tab on the online application screen will turn green. If the payment attempt fails, candidate should make the payment again after ensuring that the **Pay Application Fee** tab has not turned green even after the next login. If the account is debited in an unsuccessful transaction, under normal circumstances, steps required to be taken for the deducted amount to be refunded to the same account from which the transaction was attempted, will be completed within 5 working days from the date of transaction. The Application Acknowledgement Page generated after the completion of the online application submission process will contain the payment transaction reference number also.

V. Admit Cards

Candidates who have applied for the entrance examination (computer Based Test) can download their **Admit Cards** from the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from the date to be announced by CEE. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall along with valid ID Proof. Commissioner for Entrance Examination will not entertain any request for change of the date/centers of Entrance Examination once declared.

VI. General Instructions

- Merely appearing and qualifying in KMAT 2022 does not confer any right on the candidate for the admission to MBA Course. The selection and admission to MBA course is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility and such other criteria as may be prescribed by Government, Universities and Institutions.
- Application of candidate submitting false and fabricated information
 will be rejected and such candidate will be further debarred from
 appearing in Examinations conducted by Commissioner for Entrance
 Examination. Such candidates are liable to be prosecuted under
 applicable laws for criminal offence and suitably punished.
- Incomplete application and applications not in accordance with

- instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
- Instructions in the Information Bulletin may change/be updated based on decisions taken by competent authorities from time to time. Candidates are advised to check regularly the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in, for any further updates or information.
- Commissioner for Entrance Examination reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the KMAT 2022 even after the admit card has been issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination.
- Candidature for KMAT 2022 is purely provisional and is subject to fulfillment and proof of eligibility criteria prescribed by the admitting institutions as applicable.
