**PG MEDICAL COURSES – 2021**  
**DOCUMENT SUBMISSION FOR NRI QUOTA**  
**TIME EXTENDED FOR EMBASSY/CONSULATE ATTESTATION**

Fresh applications were invited for PG Medical Courses (as per Notification No:CEE/23/2022-TA1) based on the revised NEET PG Qualification criteria. On scrutiny of the documents submitted for NRI claim, it was noted that many candidates were unable to produce documents with Embassy/Consulate attestation before 23.03.2022, which was the last date for rectification of defects in the documents.

Based on the request received from the candidates for extension of time for submitting Embassy/Consulate attested documents for NRI claim, the following relaxations are sanctioned.

- a. Those candidates who have submitted all other mandatory documents in support of NRI claim except Embassy/Consulate attestation, their claim for NRI category will be considered provisionally.
- b. They will be permitted to participate in the Mop-up allotment provisionally.
- c. These candidates should upload the embassy/consulate attested documents before 04/04/2022.
- d. Failure to upload the document within the stipulated time will lead to the cancellation of NRI claim of the candidate, without further notice.
- e. If they secure an allotment in this phase, they should also submit all the necessary documents including the Embassy /Consulate attested original documents at the college allotted at the time of joining (on or before 04.04.2022 ).
- f. No further extension of time will be given for uploading/submitted the documents.
