SECOND ROUND MOP UP ALLOTMENT TO BDS COURSE IN SELF FINANCING DENTAL COLLEGES FACILITY TO REGISTER NEW OPTIONS

As the Medical Counselling Committee has extended the joining date for the BDS course for the academic year 2022-23 to 14.01.2023, vacancies existing in the BDS course in various Self Financing Colleges after the first round mop up allotment and further stray vacancy allotment will be filled through second round Mop up allotment to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. As there are no options available for the selffinancing Dental colleges registered through the first round mop up allotment, candidates can register new options for the second round mop up allotment. The vacancies existing in selffinancing dental colleges have been published on the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Eligible candidates, who are included in the Kerala State Medical Rank List published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register fresh options from 31.12.2022 to 03.01.2023, 5.00 PM. Those candidates who have been admitted to MBBS/BDS courses through All India Counselling/State Counselling will not be allowed to participate in the Second round Mop Up Counselling. Candidates, in order to participate in the online Mop up allotment can register options through the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in_by clicking the menu item 'Mop up Option Registration' available on the Home page.

Guidelines for Mop up counselling

- Candidates who are included in the 'Excluded candidate list' published on the website of CEE and those who are admitted to MBBS/BDS courses through All India counselling will not be allowed to participate in the second round Mop up allotment.
- Those candidates who received admission to the MBBS/BDS course up to the second round of State Quota Counselling and those candidates who received allotment/admission to the MBBS/BDS course through State quota first round Mop up allotment/Stray vacancy allotment will not be allowed to participate in the Second round mop up allotment.
- Those candidates who get an allotment through the second round mop-up allotment will not be considered for allotment to any other courses conducted by the

Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

• The seats received through the second round Mop up allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.

Mop up Registration fee

Those candidates who wish to register options in Mop up allotment will have to pay the following registration fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The registration fee can be paid online or through Post office to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations before registering options.

- Those candidates who register options to Self Financing BDS course shall have to pay an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One lakh only) as Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should pay Rs. 5000/- as Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- The registration fee for those candidates who have already paid the registration fee for the first round mop up allotment to MBBS/BDS courses and did not get any allotment will be considered the second round mop up registration fee. If the registration fee already paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations is less than the second round mop up registration fee, they will have to pay the balance registration fee.
- The registration fee applicable to a candidate will be fixed as per the details entered by the candidate in the Mop up registration page available in the Candidate Portal in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Candidates can register options for Mop up allotment only after paying the applicable Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The Registration fee, once paid, will not be changed at any instance. Thus, candidates should be very careful, while giving conditions to fix the Registration fee.
- The registration fee of those candidates who get an allotment through Mop up allotment will be carried over to the Tuition Fee of the course allotted, and the registration fee of those candidates who do not get any allotment will be refunded after the closing of admission to the BDS Course.
- The registration fee of those candidates who do not join within the stipulated time after getting an allotment and those candidates who quit seats after taking admission through Mop up allotment, will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Such students will also be penalized as per KEAM Prospectus clause 12.2.4.

If any vacancy exists in the BDS course after the second round Mop-up allotment, it will be filled through further Stray vacancy Allotment, by considering the same options registered by the candidates in the second round Mop up allotment. Those candidates who do not join after getting an allotment though Mop-up allotment as well as those who quit the seats after joining college through Mop-up allotment, will not be considered for stray vacancy allotment. Details of the stray vacancy allotment will be published later.
