# SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE NURSING COURSES (PG NURSING) -2022 FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION

The activities related to the Second Phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Post Graduate Nursing Course (PG. Nursing) in Government Nursing Colleges and Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges in the state commenced from 15.11.2022.

Candidates who have already submitted online options in the first phase and who want to participate in this phase of allotment must compulsorily confirm their existing options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available on his/her home page. After online option confirmation, such candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange their existing higher options. The facility for online option confirmation /deletion/re-arrangement will be available on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in up to 5.00 PM on 17.11.2022. Those who do not confirm their options through online within the stipulated time, will not be considered for this phase of allotment.

Those candidates who have received an allotment and taken admission in the allotted nursing college in the first phase shall also have to confirm their online options to be considered for this phase of allotment. The present admission during the first phase of allotment, if, any, of candidates who do not confirm their higher options within the stipulated time shall be retained.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clause 7** of the Prospectus at the time of admission. Candidates allotted to colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances.

SC/ST/OEC candidates/children of Registered Fishermen/inmates of Sree Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, and Government Juvenile Justice Homes allotted against merit seats are exempted from payment of fees.

### **Important**

- 1. Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment.
- 2. Candidates who receive a change of allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment, will automatically lose their current admission of the first phase. If the candidate has a change of college to their higher options in the second phase they should obtain the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their currently admitted college and joins the newly allotted colleges within the specified date notified by the CEE.
- 3. Candidates are advised not to retain unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted.
