ONLINE MOP UP ALLOTMENT- OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to Online Mop up Allotment to fill up vacant seats in Post Graduate Medical Courses-2021 in Government Medical Colleges of the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC) Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self-financing Medical Colleges commences from **27.3.2022, 6.00PM**

Eligible candidates included in the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **27.3.2022,6.00PM to 31.3.2022, 10.00 AM**. Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link '**PG Medical 2021: Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item '**Option Registration**' candidates can register their options online. The allotment based on the rank list and the online options received up to 10.00 AM on 31.3.2022 will be published on 02.04.2022. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges from **4.4.2022 to 6.4.2022, 2.00 PM**.

The schedule for Mop-up allotment is given below:

27.3.2022, 6.00PM	Website opens for Option Registration
31.3.2022, 10.00 AM	Time for Option Registration Ends
2.4.2022	Allotment Publication
4.4.2022 to 6.4.2022 ,2.00 PM	Candidates to join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges
6.4.2022, 3.00 PM	Principals of Colleges to submit non-joining report through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) to the office of CEE

Guidelines for Online Mop-Up Round Counseling

1. The Online Mop up Round will be based on the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
2. Course once allotted in the Online Mop up round shall be final. Surrender of seats after allotment in the Online Mop-Up round will not be permitted.

3. The candidates who stand admitted under All India Quota/Central Universities/Deemed Universities as per the list furnished by the DGHS, New Delhi are not eligible to participate in the Online Mop up Round.
4. Candidates who joined in PG Course in State quota in Second Phase Allotment and are holding the seat even after the last date of surrender of seat shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop up Counselling.
5. Candidates who have not joined or quit the seat allotted to them in the Second Round of the State Quota Counselling on or before 26.3.2022 shall have to pay the Exit Fee equivalent to 10 % of the annual tuition fee for the respective seats to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in order to be eligible to participate in this Online Mop up Counselling. Such candidates can access/enter the option registration page only after payment of the Exit Fee by online mode.
6. If the applicant retains the seats in the First Allotment and is not allotted any seats in the Second Round then this allotment in the First Allotment will be considered as equivalent to the seats allotted in the Second Round and the conditions for Mop up will be the same as above.
7. Those candidates including SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home who are allotted but have not joined in a course in the Second Round of Allotment can participate in the Mop up Round by paying an amount equal to 10% of annual fee of the College/Course allotted in the Second Round by Online mode.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the College/Course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies/Affiliation from the Universities concerned. All details related to the counseling/allotment process are available in the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses-2021 available on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in
