KEAM-2022 MOP UP ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES REVISED NOTIFICATION

The Notification regarding Mop up allotment to MBBS/BDS courses to fill the vacancies that have arisen in various Government/Self Financing Colleges after the second phase of allotment was published on 07.12.2022. *But some of the conditions mentioned in the notification have been cancelled by the Hon'ble High Court as per the judgement in WP (C) No. 40010 of 2022, dated 13.12.2022.* Accordingly, the revised guidelines for the mop-up allotment are given below:

Revised Guidelines for Mop up counselling

- Candidates admitted to MBBS/BDS courses up to the second round of the all-India quota allotment will be excluded from the mop-up allotment.
- Candidates admitted to MBBS/BDS courses up to the second round of state quota allotment will be excluded from the mop-up allotment.
- Candidates admitted to MBBS/BDS courses through the All India Mop-up allotment will be excluded from the Mop up allotment.
- The seats received through mop-up allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.

Based on the above guidelines, the provisional Mop up allotment will be published on 14.12.2022.

The registration fee of those candidates, who get an allotment through Mop up allotment will be carried over to Tuition Fee of course allotted and the registration fee of those candidates who will not get any allotment will be refunded.

The registration fee of those candidates who do not join with in the stipulated time after getting an allotment and those candidates who quit seats after taking admission through Mop up allotment, will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Such students will also be penalized as per KEAM Prospectus clause 12.2.4.

If any vacancy exists in MBBS/BDS courses after Mop-up allotment, it will be filled up through Stray vacancy Allotment, by considering the <u>same options</u> registered by the candidates through Mop up allotment. Those candidates who do not join after getting an allotment though Mop-up allotment and those who quit seats after joining college through

Mop-up allotment, will not be considered for stray vacancy allotment. Details of stray vacancy allotment will be published later.
