**ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE COURSES IN AYURVEDA, KERALA 2021**  
**CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION AND**  
**REGISTER OPTIONS FOR THE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PROCESS**

Applications are invited for the admission to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda in Government ,Aided and Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State.

**Participating Institutes**

Government Ayurveda Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur, Aided Ayurveda Colleges at Ollur and Kottakkal and other Self Financing Colleges.

**Eligibility for admission:**

- i. **Nativity** : Applicant should be an Indian Citizen of Kerala origin except for Foreign Quota.
- ii. **Age**: Candidates should not be over 45 years of age as on 31.07.2021, subject to a relaxation of five years in the case of SC/ST candidates. In the case of service quota candidates, the age of teachers quota candidates should be 50 as on 31.07.2021 and that in the case of medical officer quota candidates should be 46 as on 31.07.2021.
- iii. **Qualifying Criteria**: All candidates including Service quota seeking PG (Ay) courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2021-22 should have qualified the National Eligibility –Cum Entrance Test for PG (Ay) Courses (AYUSH PGET)

conducted by AIIA, New Delhi and should figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Selection of candidates including the seats reserved for Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M, Teachers Quota and for the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made on the basis of the rank obtained in Entrance Examination conducted by the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions

The minimum eligibility mark in the entrance test (AIAPGET 2021) shall be 50th percentile in the case of general category and that of SC/ST/SEBC category shall be 40th percentile. In respect of candidates belonging to Persons with Disability category, the minimum mark shall be at 45th percentile for General Category and 40th percentile for SC/ST/SEBC category.

iv. **Academic Qualifications** Candidates should have passed BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having CCIM recognition and BAMS Degree of Universities of Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the University of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay)/MS (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala without 50% of marks for theory and practical. The cut off date for completion of internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in AIAPGET 2021 shall be 31.12.2021 subject to the production of Internship Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard.

Admission of the candidate to the concerned college/course shall be subject to fulfilling of above mentioned eligibility conditions.

### **Mode of selection:**

The Selection of candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of AIAPGET 2021 rank list subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the prospectus.

### **Submission of Applications and Application Fee**

All candidates including Service quota candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda (MD Ayurveda) can apply Online from **24-01-2022** onwards through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by entering required AIAPGET 2021 details. Candidates should remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-chalan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-chalan can be made in cash at the Head post offices/Sub Post Offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee upload photo and signature of the candidates and all necessary certificates /Documents.

**Service Quota Candidates:** Service quota candidates seeking admission in general quota shall have to pay an additional amount of Rs. 1000/- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded.

Service quota candidates including those applying for Teachers Quota should send their Application by taking printout of the online application along with NOC (No Objection Certificate) and all necessary Certificates to the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram before 5pm on **28-01-2022**. Medical Officers(ISM) should send their application through their Controlling Officer (The Director, ISM Department) to the Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road , Thiruvananthapuram before 5pm on **28-01-2022**. Service quota candidates need not send their documents to Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

**5. Last date of Application :**

All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in the prospectus before 5 pm of **28-01-2022**. Defective and incomplete application will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application

No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

**OPTION REGISTRATION FOR THE CENTRALIZED ALLOTMENT PROCESS**

The selection and allotment of seats including those of In-service candidates will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) as per the Prospectus for admission to Ayurveda Post Graduate Degree courses-2021, approved by the Government of Kerala.

In order to participate in the first phase of the centralized process (CAP) to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, candidates should register

options online as part of the online application process. Option registration facility is available together with the online application registration process. Candidates can submit options by clicking the menu item '**Option Registration**' available in the home page. The list of Ayurveda colleges/courses to which Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotments will be available in the option registration page.

Candidates can give options as per their priority of the course-college-quota combinations in the option list. A candidate need to only give options to a course-college-quota combination, if he/she is sure to join the course and college under the chosen quota, if allotted. Based on the options filed by the candidates within the stipulated time the first phase allotment will be published later, detailed notification in this regard will be published in the official website.

The approved prospectus for admission to PG Ayurveda degree Courses 2021 will be published in the website soon.

- *The nativity/community/category claims made by the candidates in the online application form will be rejected, if the required documents are not uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time.*
- *As the allotment to any category or quota seat which a candidate is not eligible for will result in the loss of not only the allotted seat but also all the lower options and any other options which require that category or quota eligibility as a prerequisite, candidates must exercise utmost care while choosing the eligible category claim in the online application. So candidates are advised not to make any category or quota claim in their online application which they would not be able to substantiate with the prescribed supporting documents within the stipulated time limit.*
- *Never register options to any course or college or quota which the candidate would not like to join if allotted.*
