## ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL COURSES-2022 FIRST PHASE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The first phase of Centralised allotment to PG Dental Courses for the academic year 2022-23 in the Government Dental Colleges and Private Self Financing Dental colleges in the State is published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on 08.10.2022 and the online options filed by the candidates from 01.10.2022 to 07.10.2022, 10.00 AM. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in .

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on the '**PG Dental 2022-Candidate Portal'** by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result. The Allotment Memo will be available in the above link from 11.10.2022 onwards. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment Memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the first phase allotment memo.

The allotted candidates should report for joining the allotted colleges from **12.10.2022 to 15.10.2022, 4.00 pm** along with the required documents (as per prospectus clause 18.2.1) specified in the allotment memo. The fee, should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. The fee shown for courses in Self financing colleges is as fixed by Admission Supervisory Committee for the

academic year 2021-22 and candidates are liable to pay the fee at the revised rate as and when the fee for the academic year 2022-23 is fixed by Admission Supervisory Committee/Government. The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective college before the time specified will lose his/her present allotment as well as all the higher order options. Also a candidate who vacates the seat joined in phase I will not be considered for phase 2 allotments. His/her options will be deleted and will only be able to participate in the Mop up round wherein fresh options are registered. Such candidates will not be considered for further online allotment for the existing options.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5.00 pm on 15.10**.2022.
