ALLOTMENT TO PG AYURVEDA DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES- 2022
SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT
FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/REARRANGEMENT/DELETION

Second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree/Diploma Courses for the academic year 2022 in the State commences from 10.02.2023.

Option Confirmation is mandatory

Option Confirmation is compulsory to participate in Phase 2. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only upgradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in Phase 1 does not give confirmation of option in Phase 2 he/she will not be considered for upgradation in Phase 2, but the seat he/she joined in Phase 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in Phase 1 does not want upgradation in Phase 2, he/she may not confirm options or after confirmation, delete all registered options. For those candidates who have no allotment as per the first allotment and need to be considered for the second phase of allotment, they must confirm their options for the first phase of allotment.

Eligible candidates can log in to the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and then click the link 'PG Ayurveda 2022 – Candidate Portal' to access their home page. Candidates can re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options after clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein.

The following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second Phase of allotment by clicking the 'Confirm' button available on the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continued in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have registered options for the first phase, but did not receive any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.

23.02.2023 4.00 PM	College authorities to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) for the PG Ayurveda course.

Candidates allotted to the courses/college should remit the fee mentioned in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted and take admission as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further centralized allotments, if any. Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) No 25/ 2005/ SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS)No 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, and children of fishermen need not remit fees.
