<u>KEAM -2022</u> <u>ADMISSION TO MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES, KERALA</u> <u>ONLINE FACILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF NEET (UG) -2022 RESULT</u>

The admission to the State Quota seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges, the entire MBBS/BDS seats in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges including Minority Quota/NRI Quota and the Medical seats earmarked for candidates irrespective of their domicile for the academic year 2022-23 shall be through a Centralized Counseling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations based on the score of the candidates in NEET-UG 2022. Moreover, the admissions to other Medical courses such as Ayurveda [BAMS], Homoeopathy [BHMS], Siddha [BSMS] & Unani [BUMS] and Allied courses such as Agriculture [BSc (Hons.) Agri], Forestry [BSc (Hons.) Forestry], Veterinary [BVSc. & AH], Fisheries [BFSc.], BSc (Hons) Co-operation & Banking, B.Sc (Hons). Climate Change & Environmental Science, B.Tech Biotechnology (Under KAU) in the State for the year 2022-23 will also be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations based on the score of the candidates in NEET-UG 2022. Candidates who have appeared in NEET (UG)-2022 and opting for admission to Medical courses such as MBBS, BDS, Ayurveda, Homoeopathy, Siddha & Unani and Allied courses such as Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries shall have to submit online their NEET (UG)-2022 result details to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for preparing the respective State rank lists. The online facility for submission of NEET (UG)-2022 result details will be available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 06.10.2022 to 12.10.2022, 4.00 PM.

<u>Candidates who do not submit their NEET (UG) -2022 results to the Commissioner for</u> <u>Entrance Examinations within the stipulated time shall not be considered for preparation of</u> <u>rank list for Medical & Medical Allied courses.</u>

Candidates who have already submitted application for admission to Medical & Medical Allied courses under KEAM 2022 and who have qualified in the NEET (UG)-2022 conducted by the NTA, as per the eligible criteria mentioned in the prospectus clause 9.7.5 (ii) &(iii) can submit NEET result to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations online.

STEPS FOR SUBMITTING NEET RESULT

- i. Access the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in
- ii. Click the link '**KEAM 2022-Candidate Portal**' and provide KEAM-2022 Application number and Password to enter the Home Page of the candidate.
- iii. Click the Menu Item 'NEET Result Submission' and provide NEET (UG)-2022 Roll Number, NEET (UG)-2022 Application Number and NEET (UG)-2022 Date of Birth.
- iv. Verify the score card for NEET (UG)-2022 –Candidate's name, Name of father, Name of Mother, NEET (UG) result details shown in the screen with NEET (UG) 2022 Score NEET Percentile, All India Rank for counseling etc.
- v. If the details are correct, click the 'Verified and Submit' button. (Note:- The procedure of submission of NEET result will be complete only when the 'Verified and Submit' button is clicked).
- vi. Take the printout of '**NEET Result Submission Report**' and keep it with the candidate for future use.

Candidates should not send/upload the NEET Score Card or NEET Result Submission Report to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. All candidates are requested to go through the Government approved Prospectus for admission to Professional Degree courses-2022, available in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**
