The activities related to the second phase of allotment to the Kerala Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy/Siddha/Pharmacy/Agriculture/Veterinary/Forestry/Fisheries/Co-Operation & Banking/Climate change & Environmental Science/B.Tech Biotechnology courses (Under Kerala Agricultural University) for the State Quota Seats available will started on **03.12.2022**

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Pharmacy and Medical Allied courses to be considered in the second phase of allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the 'confirm' button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can rearrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options on Courses/colleges if applicable, from 03.12.2022 to 05.12.2022 5.00 PM. through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to consider them in the second phase allotment. The higher options of those candidates who got admission through first round allotment but vacate the seats after option confirmation will not be considered for allotment. But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received if any in the first phase shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to **5.00 PM on 05.12.2022** the second phase provisional allotment to Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Pharmacy and Medical Allied

courses will be published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in on **07.12.2022**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) shown in the allotment memo, to the allotted colleges and should join the course/college allotted. The joining schedule will be published later.

FEES

The details of fee for the Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Pharmacy and Medical Allied courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2022-23 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing colleges, those candidates who got allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2021-22 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2022-23 is higher than that of 2021-22 for these colleges.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/those communities eligible for educational concession as is given to OEC category, those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated
