KEAM-2019 MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS) ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The Online Option registration for the Mop-up Counselling to Medical & Allied Courses (Except M.B.B.S, BDS) was open from **07.09.2019** to **15.09.2019** to fill up the remaining vacant seats. All the Candidates included in the Kerala medical, Ayurveda rank lists could register new Options. As per the options received from the candidates the allotment is published herewith. In this phase, allotment is given to other Medical courses such as Ayurveda (BAMS), Homoeopathy (BHMS) Sidha, Unani and Allied courses such as Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses.

Candidates who have registered for the allotment to Medical & Allied Courses (Except M.B.B.S/BDS) shall have to log into their Home page provided in the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u>. All the candidates who have an allotment should take the printout of the Allotment Memo which will show the details such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, details of Fee to be paid etc. Candidates who receive an allotment afresh or a change in allotment than the previous one shall have to remit the fee/balance fee if any, to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of Online Payment on any date from 17.09.2019 to 18.09.2019, 4.00 pm and should join the allotted colleges before 5.00 pm on 18.09.2019. The list of Post offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, other candidates eligible for fee concession have no token deposit and should join the allotted colleges. Important:

Candidates who stand admitted in Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani courses under All India Quota and MBBS, BDS courses as per the State allotment are not considered for the Online allotment. If any Candidate who has already been admitted to Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses gets a new allotment through Mop-Up counselling as per option, his/her previous admission will be cancelled.
