## **NOTIFICATION**

### **SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE DENTAL (DEGREE ) COURSES, KERALA - 2021 FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION/DELETION/REARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE**

The activities related to the second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Dental (Degree) Courses for the year 2021 in the State commences from **22/10/2021**. The vacant seats expected to be reverted from All India Quota, the vacant seats under State quota after the first round of counseling in Government Dental Colleges and Self-financing Dental Colleges shall be filled up in this phase of allotment. The allotment to service quota seats available in Govt. dental colleges and allotment to NRI and Minority community quota seats in Self-financing Dental colleges is also included in this phase.

Candidates included in the state rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log on to the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) and then click the link 'P G Dental 2021-Candidate Portal' to access their home page. Candidates can then re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options after clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also re-arrange/delete their existing options. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement shall be available in the above website from 22.10.2021 to 25.10.2021, 03.00 pm. Those who are holding All India Quota seats as per the allotment of MCC will not be eligible to participate in this phase of allotment.

#### **Online Option Confirmation is mandatory**

The candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and the candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment shall have to confirm their options online by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in the Home page of the candidate. Those who do not Confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase of allotment for the existing options.

#### **The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below**

<b>22.10.2021</b>	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, re-arrangement/registration/ deletion of existing higher options
<b>25.10.2021, 3.00 pm</b>	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion of options ends.
<b>27.10.2021</b>	<b>Publication of second phase allotment</b>
<b>28.10.2021 - 30.10.2021, 4.00 pm</b>	All candidates who get an allotment should remit the <b>fee</b> to the allotted colleges as shown in the allotment memo and should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents.
<b>30.10.2021, 5pm</b>	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college/course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission. Candidates who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home, Juvenile home are exempted from payment of fees.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
