COMPUTED BASED ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION
TO INTEGRATED 5 YEAR LL.B COURSE, 2019-20
Instructions to Candidates

The Entrance Examination for admission to Integrated 5 Year LL.B course for the year 2019-20 shall be conducted on 08.06.2019 (Saturday) as a Computer Based Test. A total of 24 Institutions have been allocated as examination centres in Thiruvananthapuram, Kottayam, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Kozhikode and Kannur centres. Candidates are directed to report for the Entrance Examination with the Admit Card downloaded from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The Entrance Examination shall be conducted in two shifts, one Forenoon session and the other Afternoon session. Candidates allowed with Forenoon session shall have to report at the venue of the Entrance Examination between 9.30 A.M and 10.30 A.M. Candidates in the Forenoon session will not be allowed to report for Entrance Examination after 10.30 A.M. Candidates will be issued with an Access Card from the reporting point which contains the details of seat number and they have to enter the examination hall as per the seat number allotted. After the reporting of candidates is completed at 10.30 A.M, candidates will be allowed to take a 'Mock Test' for familiarisation with the Computer Based Test and thereafter the actual entrance examination will be held from 11.15 A.M to 1.15 P.M. Candidates allowed with the Afternoon session shall have to report at the venue of the Entrance Examination between 12.00 Noon and 1 P.M. Candidates in the Afternoon session will not be allowed to report for Entrance Examination after 1 P.M. After the reporting of candidates is completed at 1 P.M, candidates will be allowed to take the 'Mock Test' and thereafter the actual entrance examination will be held from 2.45 P.M to 4.45 P.M. Candidates are strictly directed not to possess electronic gadgets such as Calculators, Mobile Phones etc. Once the candidate has reported for Entrance Examination, he/she will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of the respective examination session.

Note: Candidates are directed to bring a photo identity card such as Aadhaar Card/Voter ID Card/Driving License/PAN Card along with Admit card for their proper identification in the examination hall.
