# ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE/ DIPLOMA COURSES IN AYURVEDA, KERALA 2022 CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION

- **I.** Applications are invited for admission to:
- a)Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda in the Government, Aided and Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State.
- b)Post Graduate Diploma Courses in Ayurveda in the Government and Aided Ayurveda Colleges of the State.
- II. The titles of the PG Ayurveda Degree Courses are detailed in Annexure III and Annexure III (a) of the PG Ayurveda Degree Prospectus 2022. For the PG Ayurveda Diploma title of courses, candidates can refer to Annexure III of the PG Ayurveda Diploma Prospectus 2022.

#### **III. Participating Institutes**

Post Graduate Degree courses are offered at Government Ayurveda Colleges in Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur as well as Aided Ayurveda Colleges in Ollur and Kottakkal and other Self Financing Colleges, while Post Graduate Diploma Courses are available at Government Ayurveda Colleges in Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur, and Aided Ayurveda College in Kottakkal.

## IV. Eligibility for admission:

**Nativity**: The applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala origin. Non Keralite candidates are also eligible to apply for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree All India Quota seats available in the Self Financing colleges.

**Age**:No upper age limit is specified for admission to the course. In the case of Service Quota candidates, the age limit for Teachers Quota candidates should be 50 as on 31.07.2022 and that of Medical Officer Quota candidates should be 46 as on 31.07.2022.

Qualifying Criteria: All candidates seeking PG (Ay) courses including Service quota in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2022-23 must have qualified for the National Eligibility –Cum Entrance Test for PG (Ay) Courses (AYUSH PGET) conducted by AIIA, New Delhi and should figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The selection of candidates for the seats reserved for the Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M, the Teachers Quota and the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made on the basis of the rank obtained in the Entrance Examination conducted by the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions. minimum eligibility mark in the entrance test (AIAPGET 2022) shall be the 50th percentile in the case of general category and that of SC/ST/SEBC category shall be the 40th percentile. In respect of candidates in "persons with disability" category, the minimum mark shall be at the 45th percentile for the General Category and the 40th percentile for the SC/ST/SEBC category.

## **Academic Qualifications:**

Candidates should have passed BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having CCIM recognition and the BAMS Degree of the Universities of Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the University of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay)/MS (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala with less than 50% of marks for theory and practical. The cut off date for completion of an internship towards determination of eligibility for **AIAPGET 2022 shall be 31.12.2022** subject to the production of Internship Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard at the time of admission. Admission of the candidate to the concerned college/course shall be subject to fulfilling of above mentioned eligibility conditions.

#### V.Mode of selection:

The Selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala, on the basis of the AIAPGET 2022 rank list, subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the prospectus.

# VI.Submission of Applications and Application Fee\_

All candidates, including Service Candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Ayurveda can apply online **till 09.01.2023** through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by entering the required AIAPGET 2022 details and then the candidate should remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of an e-chalan available during the submission of the online application. Payment through e-chalan can be made in cash at the Head post offices/Sub Post Offices in Kerala. Upload the candidates' photo and signature, as well as all necessary certificates and documents, after paying the required application fee.

Service Candidates, including teachers quota, should send their applications to the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before 1.00 PM on January 10, 2023, by taking a printout of the online application and sending it along with a NOC (No Objection Certificate) and all necessary

certificates. Medical Officers(ISM) should send their applications through their Controlling Officer (The Director, ISM Department) to the Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before 1.00 PM on 10-01-2023. Service candidates need not send their documents to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

## V. Last date of Application:

All candidates seeking admission to the courses should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in the prospectus before 5.00 PM of **09-01-2023**. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application

No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
