ONLINE SUBMISSION OF MARKS DATA FOR THE PREPARATION OF ARCHITECTURE RANK 2019

The Architecture (B.Arch)Rank list 2019 will be prepared by giving equal weightage to the score obtained by candidates in the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA-2019) conducted by the Council of Architecture and the marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination (Plus Two or equivalent). The candidates who have qualified in NATA-2019 and wish to be included in the Architecture Rank list 2019 shall have to submit the marks obtained in the Plus Two or equivalent Qualifying Examination and the NATA-2019 score through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

Candidates can enter the home page through <u>'KEAM 2019-Candidate Portal'</u> in the above website by giving their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking the Menu Item 'Mark Submission for Arch', the marks data can be submitted as per the instructions therein. After entry of marks, confirmation has to be done by such candidates by clicking on 'Submit Mark Data' button. Then the candidate should upload the PDF formats of Plus Two mark list and NATA-2019 Score card through the web page. The uploaded documents should be complete, readable and without any defects. After uploading the documents, the candidates should take the print out of the Mark Submission Confirmation Report through the link 'Print Mark Submission Confirmation Report' and keep it for future use. Confirmation report/mark sheet/NATA score card should not be sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates from Boards such as CBSE in which the Board marks are available for only one year need submit the marks of the second year of plus two/equivalent alone and upload the Mark list along with NATA-2019 score card. Candidates from Boards such as Kerala Higher Secondary/Vocational Higher Secondary in which Board marks are available for both the years should submit the total marks for both the years and upload the respective Mark lists along with NATA-2019 score card. Candidates who have passed Diploma course should submit the total marks of all the semesters and upload Mark lists of all the semesters along with NATA-2019 score card.

The website will be open from 25.05.2019 to 30.05.2019, 5 pm for online submission of marks in the Qualifying Examination and NATA-2019 score and for uploading the required documents. Applicants who do not submit the marks online and who have not qualified in NATA 2019 will not be considered for the preparation of Architecture Rank 2019.
