ALLOTMENT/ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL COURSES-2021

INSTITUTION-LEVEL STRAY VACANCY FILLING

ONLINE APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND OPTION REGISTRATION FACILITY FOR THE NEWLY QUALIFIED CANDIDATES, FOLLOWING LOWERING OF THE MINIMUM QUALIFYING PERCENTILE

The NEET-MDS-2021 minimum qualifying percentile has been lowered by the National Board of Examinations as per the Letter no. V.12025/154/2021/-DE, dated 10th November 2021, MoHFW as shown in the table below.

Category	Revised Minimum Qualifying Criteria (as directed by MoHFW)	Revised Cut off Score (out of 960)
General (UR/EWS)	26.971 th Percentile	185
SC/ST/OBC (including PwD of SC/ST/OBC)	16.971 th Percentile	152
General PwD (UR PwD)	21.971 th Percentile	170

Candidates who are qualified in NEET-MDS-2021 as per the newly announced revised cut-off scores and satisfy the eligibility conditions given in the prospectus for Kerala State MDS-2021 admissions can submit online application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations Kerala (website: <https://cee.kerala.gov.in>), for the institution-level stray vacancy filling to be conducted by the respective colleges, which have seats remaining vacant. The online application submission and option registration facility for the newly qualified candidates based on the revised minimum qualifying criteria will start on 13/11/2021 and those candidates who submit the online application and options upto 16/11/2021, 1.00 pm will be included in the list of probable candidates to be prepared for the institution-level stray vacancy filling. The probable list, based on the options registered by the newly qualified candidates for institutional level stray vacancy filling, will be published on the evening of 16/11/2021.

The online application procedure involves the following broad steps:

1. Registration and application form filling-up

Candidates can avail the facility of application submission through the link 'PG Dental 2021 - Re-Opening Online Application Facility' and should complete the online submission of application and upload the required documents within the timeline. The application facility is hosted in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

2. Application Fee Payment

Application fee is **RS.1000/-** (Rupees Thousand only) and in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No. 25/05/STSCDD dated 20.06.2005 is **Rs.500/-** (Rupees Five hundred only).

3. Option Registration:

The registered options will be used for preparing the lists of probable candidates to be used by the colleges for institution-level stray vacancy filling. If no vacancies exist in a college, course or quota included in the Options list, the corresponding options will be ignored while preparing the lists of probable candidates.

4 Uploading Documents:

Documents (as prescribed in the prospectus) in support of the basic eligibility along with those for the following benefits, if applicable, should be uploaded within the stipulated time limit:

- a. Fee Concession
- b. Lower NEET-MDS-2021 cut-off for reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC).
- c. Any other category claim, as per the Kerala state MDS-2021 prospectus

Those newly qualified candidates, who have already submitted online application previously, need not submit application in this phase. However, those of the newly qualified candidates who have already applied for the course, i.e., who have completed steps of applying online till '**Fill application**' of their online application need not apply again, and they can avail the facility to complete the remaining steps in this phase. Such candidates will be considered only if they are eligible as per the new criteria and conditions as laid down by the authority.

Notes:

- i. ***Specifications of the supporting documents are given in the prospectus. Documents not satisfying the specifications will be rejected.***
- ii. ***The claims and corresponding data entry made in the online application form must match the documents uploaded, and discrepancies between the two will lead to the cancellation of the claim and associated benefits. Any decision made or claim allowed based on the data entry related to a category claim in the application form will be revoked if the data provided in the application form is found not having or matching the required supporting document(s) uploaded.***

Before registration, candidates should go through the detailed notification published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on 30/09/2021 and the Prospectus for Admission to Post Graduate Dental Courses-2021.
