SPOT ADMISSION TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS)

The Spot admission to fill up the vacant seats if any arising after the Online Mop-Up Counselling is scheduled to be held on 20.09.2019, 10.00 am at **Travancore International Convention Centre, (Greenfield Stadium) Kariavattom, Thiruvananthapuram.** Candidates included in the Kerala medical, Ayurveda rank lists can participate in the spot admission. Candidates who wish to participate in the spot admission must register by visiting the home page of the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> and download the slip by clicking in the link '**Registration** slip-Spot' available in the candidate portal from 18.09.2019, 6.00 pm onwards. The registration slip is essential for participating in the admission process.

Details of Fee and mode of remittance:

Candidates getting allotment during the spot admission shall have to remit the fee as given below at the venue of spot admission by way of Demand Draft drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

- 1. Candidates getting allotment to Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses Rs.19,800.
- 2. Candidates getting allotment in Government/Aided Ayurveda colleges Rs.12,000 and Candidates getting allotment in Government/Aided Homoeo colleges Rs.2,087.
- 3. Candidates getting allotment in Self financing Ayurveda/Siddha Unani colleges Rs.1,00,000 /-
- 4. Candidates, who have remitted any fee amount to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the allotment, if any, under Medical & Allied courses except MBBS & BDS courses need to submit the Demand Draft for the balance amount only.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Spot Admission:

Candidates who wish to participate in the Spot Admission should appear in person for the Spot Admission with the following documents.

- 1) Spot Admission Slip
- 2) Demand Draft for the requisite amount
- 3) Candidates who are admitted in Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses shall have to produce the <u>self- attested</u> <u>copies of all the certificates showing his/her educational qualifications</u>, a '<u>No</u> <u>Objection Certificate</u>' obtained from the Head of the institution in which the candidate is presently admitted, stating that the institution has no objection in relieving the candidate and a '<u>Possession Certificate</u>' obtained from the Head of the institution presently admitted, stating that the original documents of the candidate including Transfer

Certificate is under the safe custody of the institution. Candidates admitted in any other courses/colleges may produce the original Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended, Conduct Certificate and Original mark list(s) of the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary or equivalent) along with the Pass certificate of the qualifying examination (if issued).

- 4) Eligibility certificate from any University in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE.
- 5) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- 6) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- 7) Data sheet of KEAM 2019.
- 8) Physical Fitness Certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure XVII (b) of the Prospectus 2019.

Note:-

- Candidates who stand admitted in Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani courses under All India Quota and MBBS, BDS courses as per the State allotment shall not be considered for the Mop-Up Counselling. If the Candidate who has already been admitted to Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses gets allotment in new colleges through spot admission, his/her previous admission will be cancelled.
- Transfer between two government/Aided colleges or between two Self -Financing colleges shall not be permitted at any stage of the spot-admission for the same course. Transfer from government to Aided colleges and vice versa for the same course will also be not permitted.
- Transfer between two different courses and transfer from a Self-Financing college to government/aided college and vice versa for the same course shall be allowed.
