

PG Ayurveda (Degree) Courses  
Vacancy Filling at Institution Level-Round II  
GUIDELINES

Eligible candidates should report before the concerned college authority with all the documents including TC in original, and the fee should be paid to the college before the end of the reporting period.

**Reporting Period: 19.04.2022 to 23.04.2022, 2.00PM.**

***A. Determining the list of candidates to be considered for vacancy filling.  
(prepared by the office of CEE)***

1. For this phase of vacancy filling allotment at the institution level, candidates included in the List I: Probable List can be considered for giving admission to concerned courses having vacant seats in Govt.Ayurveda College. List-II : Candidates List has also been provided to be considered for admission to vacant seats in Self-Financing Ayurveda Colleges. Eligibility criteria is fixed in this vacancy filling phase in such a way that the candidates satisfy the following condition:
  - a. The candidates were included in the Kerala State Merit List PG Ayurveda published on 02-03-2022.
  - b. The candidate is not admitted in seats allotted by the AACCC of the Ministry of AYUSH. Candidates admitted through mop up allotment, allotted through stray vacancy filling round and candidates admitted are not eligible for admission.
  - c. The candidate should have registered for the Mop-Up phase of counseling to PG Ayurveda courses. The conditions to choose and order online options as stipulated in Para (1) of the Notification dated 04.03.2022 is applicable in the preparation of List I: Probable List.
  - d. The candidates should have opted the concerned college/course in Mop Up counseling to PG Ayurveda courses in Govt Ayurveda colleges.
  - e. Vacancies that may arise during the phase, vacancies that are not enlisted at this stage may also be filled from the lists provided.
2. All the candidates included in the probable list I and Candidates List II are eligible to be considered in the vacancy filling phase.If seats remain vacant in Govt Ayurveda Colleges even after considering Probable List I, List II, provided will be taken into account for filling up the remaining vacancies in these colleges

***B. Guidelines for Allotment ( to be followed by the colleges and candidates)***

- 1.Vacancy filling should not be on First-Come, First-Served basis alone, but rank, possession of documents to be produced before the authority shall be considered.
2. Eligible candidates can report before the concerned college authority with all the required documents in original including Transfer Certificate. All the documents listed in the prospectus, as the documents to be submitted to the college authority

for taking admission, should be submitted to the concerned college authority before the end of the reporting period. The fees should also be paid to the college before the end of the reporting period. The reporting period for this particular vacancy filling phase is 2.00 PM on 23.04.2022. However, if the candidate and the college agree to employ a particular mode of banking facility for fee payment which closes before at the end of the normal reporting time, the closing time of the banking facility will be the deadline as far as fee payment is concerned.

3. Candidates must be qualified as per AIAPGET 2021 academic eligibility.
4. No actual seat allocation should be done before the end of the reporting period, and the admission finalization should be done in rank order only, from the candidates reported before the college authority satisfying the conditions in the previous Para. 2 and 3. Admission finalization should be done only after the reporting period ends. Fees collected from candidates who are not finally admitted should be promptly refunded.
5. College authorities should verify the rank as well as the category status of the candidates using the **Data Sheet** to be brought by the candidates.
6. No candidate other than one in the lists published by the CEE is eligible for admission.
7. The colleges should forward the following lists to the CEE on 23.04.2022, 3.00 PM:
  - i. The list of candidates who have reported before the college authority.
  - ii. The list of rejected candidates, if any, with the reason(s) for rejection.
  - iii. The list of candidates finally admitted. The lists should include PG Ayurveda Roll Number, Course admitted, PG Ayurveda rank, AIAPGET Rank, Admitted category, Reporting time and the Name of the candidate.
