NOTIFICATION

KEAM 2020 - B.Pharm (Govt. Colleges Only) Stray Vacancy Filling – Allotment List Published

The vacancies remaining after the latest online mop-up allotment for B.Pharm course in Govt. Colleges is published in KEAM-2020 Candidate Portal on the website, www.cee.kerala.gov.in. These vacancies will be filled up as per the following guidelines:

1. Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) has prepared a seat allotment against these vacancies based on the online options collected for the online mop-up allotment for B. Pharm course in Govt. Colleges, excluding the options of those candidates who have been allotted a seat (irrespective of joining status) in the online mop-up allotment for B. Pharm course in Govt. Colleges. The college-wise lists (collectively referred to as the **Allotment List**) of candidates who have an allotment as per this seat allotment are published in KEAM-2020 candidate portal on the website, www.cee.kerala.gov.in. **Candidates included in Allotment List should report at the college concerned with all the required documents and fees so as to complete the admission process on or before 4 PM, on 15-02-2021.** The tuition fee to be paid at the time of admission is ₹15,750/-. Candidates eligible for fee concession need not pay the tuition fee. Whether a candidate is eligible for fee concession is specified in his/her KEAM-2020 'Data Sheet'.
2. For the vacancies, if any, remaining after the last date for candidates from the **Allotment List** to join the allotted colleges, the schedule and conditions of the subsequent Stray Vacancy Filling process, if any, will be described in a subsequent notification to be published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) or the Director of Medical Education (DME).

Note:

- i. For candidates already admitted in other courses for which the mop-up allotment is over or the last date of admission is over, the eligibility of the candidate to take admission to B.Pharm course at this stage is subject to the conditions specified in the related notifications and the relevant clauses of the prospectus.
- ii. Candidates from the **Allotment List** once admitted to B.Pharm course will not be eligible to further participate in any other allotments. Also, candidates included in the **Allotment List**, irrespective of whether they join or not join the allotted college, will not be allowed to participate in any subsequent allotments to B.Pharm course. These two conditions will be applicable for subsequent stray vacancy filling allotments, if any, also.
- iii. So, essentially, any candidate who is allotted a B.Pharm seat in the mop-up allotment or subsequent stray vacancy filling allotments, irrespective of whether she/he joins or not joins the allotted college, will not be considered further for allotments to B.Pharm course. Also, a candidate once admitted to B.Pharm course through mop-up allotment or stray vacancy filling allotment will not be considered further for any other allotments.

1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Candidates included in the <i>Allotment List</i> have to join the allotted college on or before <u>15.02.2021, 4:00 PM.</u>• Candidates have to pay the fees directly to the college at the time of admission.• The college authorities are to report the vacancy details to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE), on 15.02.2021, 5:00 PM.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on whether vacancies remain after the above joining time is over, a subsequent Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment may be conducted, and if so the CEE or the DME will publish a notification describing the conditions and schedule of that Allotment.• Subsequent Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment, if any, will be conducted by considering the online options of the candidates who have submitted online options for the online mop-up allotment for B.Pharm course in Govt. Colleges, excluding the candidates who have been allotted a seat (irrespective of joining status) in the online mop-up allotment for B.Pharm course in Govt. Colleges and those who have been included in the current Allotment List.
