ADMISSION IN NEWLY INCLUDED DENTAL COLLEGE
CANDIDATES CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE INSTITUTION WISE ADMISSION

In compliance with the order of Hon'ble supreme Court in SL(w)13923-13924/2020 dated 27/1/2021 Commissioner for Entrance Examinations has been directed to take necessary action to admit interested candidates for admission to BDS course to the Self-financing Dental college, Kannur Dental College Anjarakandi. In the circumstances, eligible candidates can participate in the institution wise allotment to BDS course to be conducted by Kannur Dental college, Anjarakandi. The admission of the students to BDS course in the college shall be subject to satisfying the conditions required for affiliation of the college as per the regulations of Dental Council of India and Kerala University of Health Sciences. Admission to the seats will be done by the college authority before 4.00 pm of 30.01.2021 in accordance with the guidelines for admission to the course.

Candidates in order to be considered for the seats should have the following eligibility:

- Should be included in Kerala State Medical Rank List 2020 published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Must be qualified as per the eligibility criteria of NEET 2020.
- Should not be presently admitted in a medical college/dental college for MBBS/BDS course.
- Should have the academic qualification as stipulated in clause 6.2 and other condition of the KEAM 2020 prospectus.

Candidates may report before the college authorities with originals of all the documents as per clause 11.7.1 of the KEAM 2020 prospectus before **4pm of 30.01.2021**. College authority will admit candidates who have reported within the allotted time to the seats available in the said dental college in accordance with the guidelines for admission and strictly adhering to the conditions as stipulated in KEAM 2020 prospectus. In the event of non-reporting of eligible candidates to respective category seats, college authority shall convert the category seat to another eligible category as per the prospectus condition. The colleges should forward the lists of admitted students to the CEE on **30.01.2021, 5.00 pm**
