SECOND PHASE ONLINE MOP-UP ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED**

The allotment for admission to the vacant seats available in Government /Aided Engineering/Architecture and to the vacant seats of B. Pharm courses in Government Pharmacy colleges after the first phase Mop-Up allotment are published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). The allotment is published on the basis of the Online option confirmation filed by the candidates upto 26.11.2020, 4.00 pm. The allotment details will be available in the home page of candidates in the above website.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available in the home page of the candidate and also in the Allotment Memo. The candidates should take a printout of the allotment memo from the Home Page.

Candidates who receive an allotment afresh and who get a change in allotment than that of the previous allotment should remit the fees (if any) to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of Online Payment on any date from **29.11.2020 to 01.12.2020** for Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy courses and should join the course/college allotted, before 3 pm on **01.12.2020**.

Candidates who have an allotment can download the 'Data Sheet' containing the basic details of the candidates by clicking the menu item 'Data Sheet' available in the home page of the candidate. The printout of this Data Sheet, allotment memo and other documents as per prospectus clause 11.7.1 are to be produced before the college authorities at the time of admission.

*Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) and who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment*

**Note:-**

*Those candidates who have got admission in the Government /Aided colleges, through previous allotments, who have receive an allotment in this phase must join the allotted colleges. The admission of such candidates as per the previous allotment will stand cancelled.*
