ALLOTMENT TO MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS, BSMS COURSES) FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION AND OPTION REGISTRATION

The activities related to the third phase of allotment to Agriculture/ Veterinary/ Forestry/Fisheries courses and second phase of allotment to Ayurveda/Homoeo courses, and first phase of allotment to Unani course began on **03.01.2021**.

As per the Government Letter of AYUSH (A) Department (No. A3/330/2020/AYUSH dated. 01.12.2020) allotment to 15% of the seats to BUMS Course in Self-Financing Unani college in Kerala irrespective of candidate's domicile will also be done by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Allotment to these seats will be done considering the online options received from the candidates in this phase and based on the State Ayurveda rank list 2020 published by the Commissioner for the Entrance Examinations.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

The Candidates who want their higher order options in Ayurveda/Homoeo/ Agriculture/Veterinary/Forestry/Fisheries courses to be considered shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, candidates can re-arrange their higher order options or delete the unwanted options and also register fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges if applicable, from **03.01.2021 to 06.01.2021**, **10.00 am**, through the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u>. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the prior allotment conducted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations to consider them in this phase of allotment in the case of Ayurveda/Homoeo/Agriculture/Veterinary/ Forestry/Fisheries courses. But for those who do not confirm their options, the admission in the prior phase shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to 06.01.2021, 10.00 am, the allotment will be published in the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> on 07.01.2021. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of Online Payment on any date from 08.01.2021 to 12.01.2021, 3 pm. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the course/college allotted before 3 pm on 12.01.2021.

08.01.2021 to 12.01.2021, 3.00 pm	Candidates who receive allotment should remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to CEE in any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course for Medical & Medical allied courses.
12.01.2021, 4.00 pm	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) for Medical & Medical allied courses.

FEES:

The details of fee for the Medical & Medical allied courses, in various colleges is available in the website.

Those candidates who get allotment to Government /Aided colleges should pay the complete fee to CEE. Those candidates who get allotment to Self-financing colleges should pay the fee mentioned in the allotment memo to CEE.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra home, Juvenile home, Nirbhaya home need not remit fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Note:

- 1. Allotment of candidates who have admitted in BDS course will lose their BDS allotment, if they get allotment as per their options in Medical & Medical allied courses.
- 2. Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
