ONLINE MOP UP COUNSELLING TO MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS COURSES) FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION REGISTRATION

Vacancies in Medical & Medical allied courses (except MBBS, BDS courses) will be filled through Online Mop Up counselling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Siddha course of Santhigiri siddha college and Ayurveda course of KMCT Ayurveda colleges are newly included in this phase of allotment. In order to participate in the mop up counselling, candidates who are included in the Kerala State Medical/Ayurveda Rank List (2020) published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register fresh options from 08.02.2021 to 12.02.2021, 3.00 pm.

Candidate those who are newly qualified (as per the letter of Central AYUSH F.NO.R.14011/2/2021-EP-1 dated. 15.01.2021) by lowering of cut off percentile of NEET-2020 can also register fresh option to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS/BSMS courses. Candidates can register their options from 08.02.2021 to 12.02.2021, 3.00 pm through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in by clicking the menu item 'Mop up Option Registration' available in the Home page. The Mop Up allotment will be published on 15.02.2021.

Note:

- 1. Candidates shall give options to the colleges/courses in which they wish to join if they got allotment. Keam 2020 prospectus clause 12.2.4. will be applicable to those candidates who get an allotment through this Mop up allotment and who do not take admission within the stipulated time.
- 2. Since the probable vacancies that may arise during the course of Mop up allotment have to be filled there in itself, candidates shall give options to all colleges in which they wish to study for the course, if they get an allotment.
- 3. If the candidates, who have been allotted in Medical & Medical allied courses through previous phases of allotment by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, get a new allotment through the mop up counselling, previous allotment of the candidate will stand cancelled. Hence candidates should be vigilant while giving options for considering in the online Mop Up allotment.
- 4. Those candidates who have been allotted through All India counselling in BAMS/BHMS/BSMS/BUMS course will not be allowed to participate in the Mop Up Counselling.
- 5. Those candidates who have been allotted through All India counselling in MBBS/BDS course will not be allowed to participate in the Mop Up Counselling. Similarly those candidates who have been allotted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in MBBS/BDS course will also be not allowed to participate in the Mop Up Counselling.

6. After having the Mop Up allotment, if any vacancy arises it will be filled based on the online options registered by the candidates from 08.02.2021 to 12.02.2021, 3.00 pm.

Those candidates who get allotment to Government /Aided colleges should pay the complete fee to CEE. Those candidates who get allotment to Self-financing colleges should pay the fee mentioned in the allotment memo to CEE.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra home, Juvenile home, Nirbhaya home need not remit fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
