MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS COURSES) SECOND PHASE MOP UP ALLOTMENT RESULT PUBLISHED

Mop Up allotment to Medical & Medical allied courses (except MBBS/ BDS courses) has been published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in by considering the vacancies remaining after the Mop Up allotment (published on 15.02.2021). Allotment details such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. are available in the home page of KEAM 2020-Candidate portal. The allotment details are also available in the Allotment Memo, which can be printed from the home page of candidate portal.

Candidates who get the Allotment shall have to join at the allotted college before 24.02.2021, 3.00 pm. Before joining the college, those candidates who are demanded to pay the fee (specified in the allotment memo as 'fee to be paid at CEE') shall have to remit the requisite fee to CEE by way of Online Payment or in any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala. Candidates eligible for fee concession need not pay the tuition fee. Whether a candidates is eligible for fee concession is specified in his/her KEAM 2020 Data Sheet. Candidates are advised to report at the allotted college with in the stipulated time by producing the Allotment Memo, KEAM Data Sheet and other original documents/Certificates specified in Clause 11.7.1 of the KEAM prospectus.

College authorities shall approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through online Admission Management System (OAMS) at 4.00 pm, 24.02.2021. Candidates are instructed to verify their joining status by logging into the candidate portal.

Candidates who got allotment in the previous Mop Up allotment will lose the admission if he gets allotment in this Mop Up Counselling. If any vacancy arises after the Mop Up allotment, it will be filled by the colleges and will be notified later. The candidates are advised to keep in touch with the CEE website www.cee.kerala.gov.in for updates.

Note: Liquidated damages as stipulated in clause 12.2.4(c)(ii) of the KEAM 2020 Prospectus shall be applicable to those candidates who lapse seats after being allotted in Mop up counselling or admitted through any of the prior allotments by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Moreover, such candidates shall not be considered for further allotment process
