## **NOTIFICATION**

### **APPLICATION INVITED FOR ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE COURSE IN PHARMACY (M.PHARM)- 2026**

Applications are invited from the candidates who have qualified in the Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (G-PAT) –2024/2025/2026, for admission to the Post Graduate Course in Pharmacy (M.Pharm) 2026-27 in the Government Pharmacy Colleges and in the Government merit quota seats in Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges in Kerala.

#### **1. Eligibility for Admission:**

##### **(a) Academic:**

The candidates who have passed the B.Pharm Degree examination from any of the Universities in Kerala or from any other Universities recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur as equivalent thereto by completing the studies and associated activities from an institution recognized by the All India Council of Technical Education, New Delhi and the Pharmacy Council of India, with a minimum of **55% marks** for all the three years of the B.Pharm Examination (B.Pharm- II, III, IV year) taken together, will be eligible for admission. For candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, a minimum of **50%** of the marks for all three years of the B.Pharm Examination (B.Pharm - II, III, IV year) taken together, is required for admission. For In-service candidates seeking admission against the service quota, the minimum marks required shall also be **55%**. Candidates who have passed their B.Pharm course from Universities outside Kerala will be eligible for admission only if their qualifying examination is recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, before the last date specified for the submission of academic data. For candidates having not less than 5 years of professional experience, after passing the B.Pharm course, there shall be a

relaxation in the pass percentage from **55% to 50%** for admission to the M.Pharm course.

**(b) Nativity:**

Only Indian Citizens of Kerala origin are eligible for admission to the M.Pharm Course 2026. To prove Nativity, the candidate has to upload, along with the Online Application, any one of the certificates specified in Clause 3.1 of the M.Pharm Prospectus.

**(c) Age:**

There is no upper age limit for general quota candidates for admission to the M.Pharm Course - 2026. Service quota candidates should have at least **five years** of service for superannuation after the completion of the course (as per clause 8.1 of Prospectus).

**2. Qualifying Criteria:**

In order to be eligible for admission to the Postgraduate course in Pharmacy (M. Pharm) in 2026, it shall be necessary for all the candidates including those who apply under the Service Quota, to have qualified in the **Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (G-PAT) –2024/2025/2026**, and figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala. Candidates who have qualified in a category other than the General (UR-ALL) category as per the **G-PAT - 2024/2025/2026**, result published by the NBEMS must upload the required documents or undergo the verification process, as the case may be, prescribed in the prospectus to substantiate the respective category claim, failing which the candidature of the applicant will be cancelled. The applicants under service quota should have completed probation under regular appointment in the concerned department to become eligible to apply.

**3. Mode of Selection:**

The selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Kerala on the basis of the rank of the qualified candidates in the **Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT)- 2024/2025/2026**, and subject to other eligibility conditions prescribed in clause 3 of the Prospectus approved by the Government. In case of a tie in GPAT score, the candidate (including service quota) with the

higher mark for B.Pharm (4 year marks/ 7 & 8 semesters marks) will be placed higher. If the tie still persists, the candidate greater in age will be placed higher. Those who are not qualified by the **GPAT-2024/2025/2026**, are not eligible for admission.

#### **4. How to Apply:**

Candidates who have qualified in the respective category in **GPAT 2024/2025/2026**, including Service candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Pharmacy course (M.Pharm) 2026, can apply Online through the link '**M.Pharm-2026 Online Application**' available in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** till **08.07.2026, 11.59 PM**. **While applying online, candidates should upload the GPAT Score card of 2024/2025/2026, as the case may be.** The scanned image of their recent photograph, signature, and all the required documents/certificates to prove their claims, including their reservations, as per the instructions given in the Prospectus (clause 9.2.4) shall also be uploaded. No need to send the printout of the Application Acknowledgement page or any supporting documents to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

#### **5. Application Fee:**

All candidates, including Service candidates, shall remit the required fee through online by using internet banking/credit card/debit card. **Application Fee for General/Service candidates is Rs.650/-** ( Rupees Six hundred and fifty only) and in the case of **SC/ST candidates the application fee is 325/-** (Rupees Three hundred and twenty five only).

#### **6. Service quota candidates:**

Service quota candidates, in addition to applying online, should forward a copy of the Application Acknowledgement page along with all required documents including their service details, to the Controlling Officer concerned as stipulated in clause 9.2.5 of the Prospectus, on or before **11.59 PM on 08.07.2026**.

**Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard.**

## **7. Centralized Allotment Process:**

The selection of candidates for admission, including those under the Service Quota will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through a Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) based on various provisions laid down in the Prospectus approved by the Government.

Candidates are advised to go through the various provisions in the Prospectus for admission to the Post Graduate Course in Pharmacy (M.Pharm)-2026 available on the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) before filling up the Online application.
