CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT FRESH APPLICATIONS FOR
ADMISSION TO
MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES

AND

KEAM APPLICANTS CAN ADD COURSES & RESERVATION
CLAIMS FOR ADMISSION TO MEDICAL & MEDICAL
ALLIED COURSES

Fresh online applications are invited for admission to Medical & Medical Allied courses (including newly added courses such as BSc (Hons.) Horticulture , Integrated Biology/Microbiology etc. under KAU) in the State from candidates, **who have not yet submitted applications** to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM 2026. In the case of candidates **who have already submitted applications** under KEAM 2026 for admission to any of the courses such as Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy , facilities will be available for addition of Medical & Allied courses , and for addition of NRI, Minority & Category Claim to the already submitted application . For Medical & Medical allied courses, only those who have qualified in NEET-UG 2026 conducted by NTA will be considered.

The facility for online submission of fresh applications and addition of

course /claim(s) to the already submitted application will be available on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance examinations from **23.07.2026 (AN) to 27.07.2026, 11.00 AM.**

How to apply

To submit fresh applications: *(Only for candidates who have not already submitted application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM-2026. Fresh application of the candidates who have already submitted the application will be rejected.)*

The candidates who have not submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for admission to Professional Degree Courses through KEAM-2026 can submit fresh online application for admission to Medical & Medical Allied courses. Candidates must register through the link '**KEAM 2026-Online Application**' provided in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. On clicking the link, the candidate will be directed to a web page containing the online application. After completing the different steps for submission of the online application illustrated in clause 7.4 of the Prospectus for KEAM 2026, candidate should download the Application Acknowledgement Page and keep a copy of it for future reference. Candidates need not send the printout of the Acknowledgement page or other documents to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

To add Medical & Medical Allied course and NRI/Category/Minority Claims to the already submitted application :

(Only for candidates who have already submitted application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM-2026 for any of the courses)

For this, the candidates should enter the home page through the link '**KEAM 2026-Candidate Portal**' on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** by giving Application Number and Password. By clicking the menu, "Add Course", candidates can select and add Medical & Medical Allied courses (only for those who have qualified in NEET-UG 2026 conducted by NTA). Candidates should not submit a new application for this.

By clicking the menu, "**Upload NRI Document**" / "**Upload Category/Minority**", candidates can select the respective reservation claim, as the case may be. Applicants who want to be considered for admission to various reserved category seats based on community or NRI quota or EWS quota (Economically Weaker Section under General Category) or Minority quota should submit the required supporting documents (Community Certificate, Non Creamy Layer Certificate for State education purpose, EWS certificate for state education purpose, NRI documents, etc. as the case may be) to substantiate the claims for reservation. There will be no opportunity to submit supporting documents later under any circumstances.

Payment of Application Fee: The required Application Fee/Additional Application fee can be paid by way of online payment only.

Important:

1. *Candidates who have already submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance examinations under KEAM 2026 as per the earlier Notifications for any of the courses such as Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses **should not** submit fresh applications for admission to Medical & Medical Allied courses. Such candidates can add the required course /claim(s) in the already submitted application as per their eligibility through the link '**KEAM 2026-Candidate Portal**'. Multiple applications may lead to the*

cancellation of candidature as per the KEAM 2026 prospectus conditions.

2. *Fresh applicants who wish to be considered for admission to various reservation category seats based on community or any special reservation or NRI quota or EWS quota (Economically Weaker Section under General Category) or Minority quota or for any income based fee concessions, should submit, along with the online application, the required supporting documents (Community Certificate, Non Creamy Layer Certificate for State education purpose, EWS certificate for state education purpose, income certificate, NRI documents, etc. as the case may be) to substantiate the claims for reservation or fee concession. There will be no opportunity to submit supporting documents later under any circumstances.*

All candidates are requested to go through the Notification dated **05.01.2026** and Government approved Prospectus for admission to Engineering, Architecture, Pharmacy, Medical & Medical Allied courses, related Government orders available in the website **www.cce.kerala.gov.in**, before submission of fresh application/course addition/reservation claim.
