SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO PG PHARMACY COURSE- 2026 **FACILITY FOR SECOND PHASE ONLINE OPTION REGISTRATION**

The activities related to the second phase of centralized allotment for PG Pharmacy Courses for the year 2026 have commenced. Candidates who received an allotment in various pharmacy colleges during the first phase, as well as those who did not receive an allotment, can register their options online to be considered for the second phase. Candidates seeking an allotment in a PG Pharmacy course for the second phase must log into their Candidate Portal via the "**M.Pharm-2026- Candidate Portal**" link and complete their option registration by clicking the "**Option Registration**" menu. The candidates can register options from **14.09.2026 to 17.09.2026, 5:00 PM**, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Online option registration is mandatory for those who wish to get admission in the Second Phase Allotment. On the basis of options received up to 17.09.2026, 5:00 , the provisional allotment will be published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in on 18.09.2026. Candidates who receive an allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee at the allotted college from **22.09.2026 to 24.09.2026** and join the allotted course/college before **4:00 PM on 24.09.2026**. The schedule for the second phase allotment is given below:

14.09.2026	Start of Option registration
17.09.2026, 5:00 PM	End of Online Option registration
18.09.2026	Publication of Provisional Allotment

19.09.2026	Publication of Final Allotment
22.09.2026 to 24.09.2026,4:00 PM	Joining Time

Candidates allotted to the courses/college should remit the fee mentioned in the allotment slip at the college allotted and take admission as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment. Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not remit fees.

Conditions

- a. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded.
- b. If a candidate gets allotment in the second phase and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded.
- c. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission in the second phase will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded
