SECOND ROUND ONLINE VACANCY FILLING ALLOTMENT TO
B.PHARM COURSE - ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Second round Online Vacancy Filling Allotment to B.Pharm Course for the year 2026-27 have commenced. All the eligible candidates who are included in the Kerala Rank List for the B.Pharm Course published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in till **5:00 PM on 29.09.2026**.

Candidates shall have to click '**KEAM-2026 - Candidate Portal**' available on the above website and enter their application number and password in order to access their Home Page. Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu '**Option Registration (B.Pharm)**' available on the Home Page.

Tentative schedule

1.10.2026	Publication of Provisional Allotment
3.10.2026	Publication of Final Allotment

Option Registration Fee:

- Candidates who have not taken admission in the previous allotments or those who have obtained Transfer Certificate and wish to register fresh options in the Stray Vacancy Allotment shall remit ₹2000/- as Registration Fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories, beneficiaries under G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD dated 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, and candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, and Nirbhaya Home shall pay ₹500/- as Registration Fee.
- The Registration Fee of candidates who secure allotment through Stray Vacancy Filling will be adjusted against the Tuition Fee.
- The Registration Fee of candidates who do not secure any allotment will be refunded.
- The Registration Fee will not be refunded for candidates who fail to join the allotted seat within the stipulated time; in such cases, it will be treated as penalty.

Important Instructions:-

Candidates should exercise options only for the colleges where they genuinely wish to secure admission, if allotted. The following categories of candidates are eligible to participate in this Stray Vacancy Allotment process:

- Those who have already secured admission in Government or Private Self-financing colleges in previous phases.
- Those who did not take admission despite an allotment.
- Those who obtained a Transfer Certificate after admission.
- Those who have not yet received any allotment

Candidates who receive an allotment through this process will forfeit their existing admission. Options may be registered to all colleges where the candidate is willing to join, as the newly vacant seats arising from transfers of already admitted students will also be filled in this phase. Please note that the options submitted in earlier allotments will not be considered for the Online Stray Vacancy Allotment. Candidates who fail to register fresh

options within the stipulated time will not be considered for this allotment.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges before 7.10.2026, 04.00 PM and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. No extension of time for joining the college will be granted under any circumstances.
