### **ADMISSION TO DNB (POST MBBS) COURSE, KERALA-2025** **STRAY VACANCY FILLING ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED**

The Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment List to fill up the vacant seats in DNB (Post MBBS) Courses for the year 2025 is published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). The allotment list is available in the '**DNB (Post MBBS) 2025-Candidate Portal**'.

To view the Allotment Result, candidates should log on to the '**DNB (Post MBBS) 2025-Candidate Portal**' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their Allotment Result. It is necessary to take the printout of Allotment Memo. The allotted candidate should report for joining at the allotted colleges **from 26.02.2026 to 28.02.2026, 4.00 PM** along with the required documents specified in the Allotment Memo and Prospectus. Head of the Institution will be personally responsible for verification of eligibility conditions as prescribed in the Prospectus, when the candidate reports for admission. Only those candidates who are found to be qualified as prescribed shall be admitted to the college/institution irrespective of the fact that he/she has an allotment.

Course once allotted in this phase shall be final. Surrender of seats after allotment will not be permitted.

All the admitting authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **5.00 PM on 28.02.2026**.

Candidates are requested to go through the various provisions with regard to the allotment process in the Prospectus for admission to DNB (Post MBBS) Courses-2025 available on the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) and also requested to visit the website regularly for updates.
